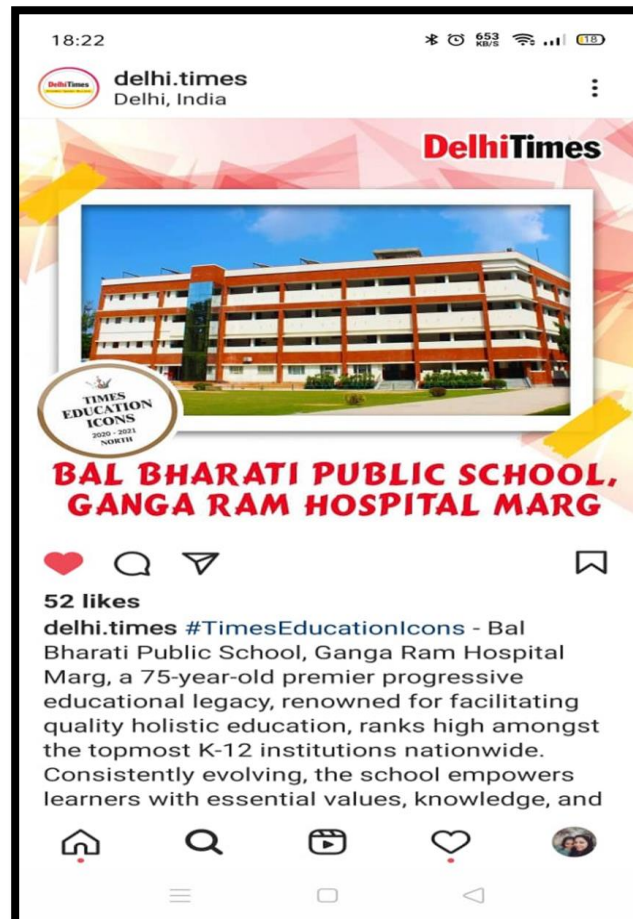


# Awards and Accolades

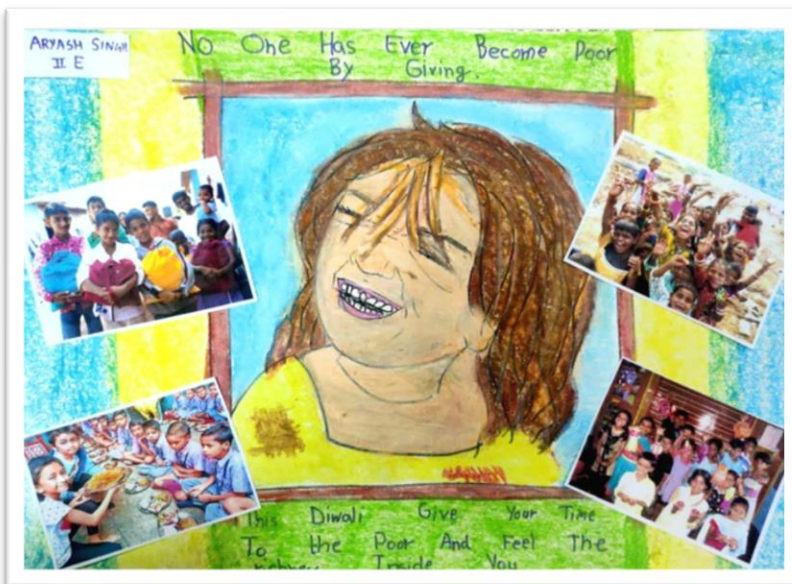

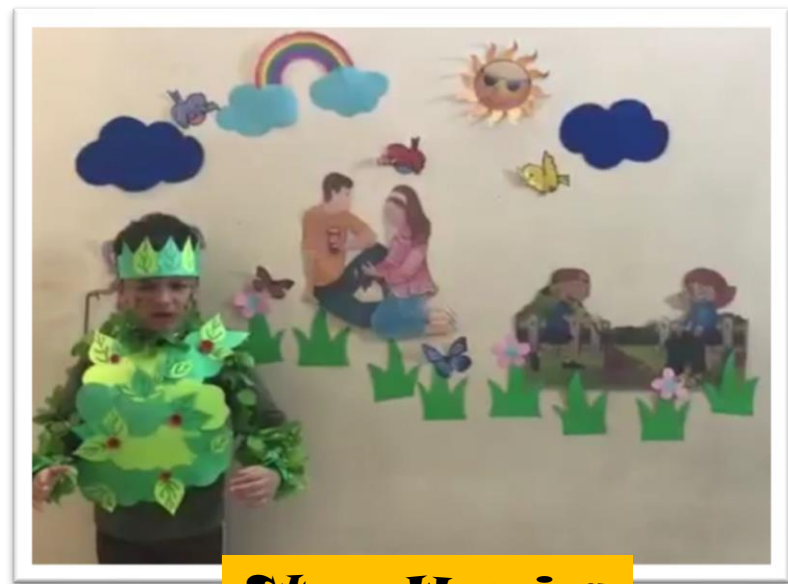


## Bal Sabha Activities

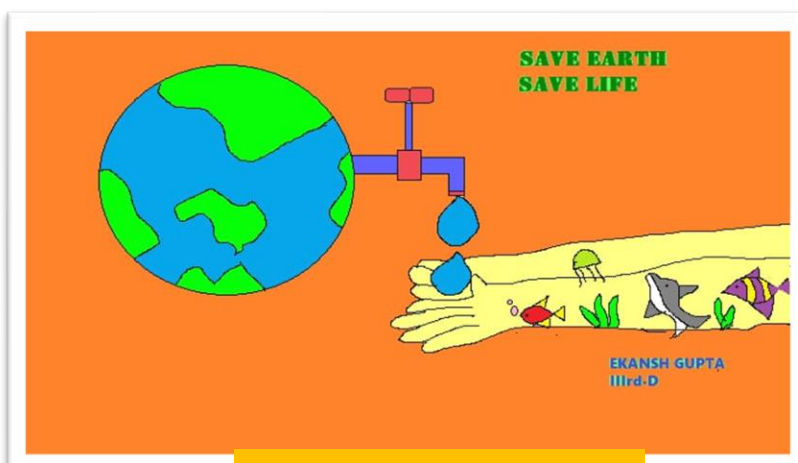

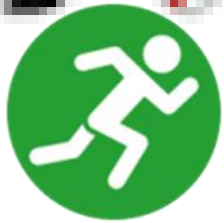
### Yoga Display (27.11.2020)

In the competition conducted each student got one minute to perform two asanas learnt by exhibiting proper body posture and movements.





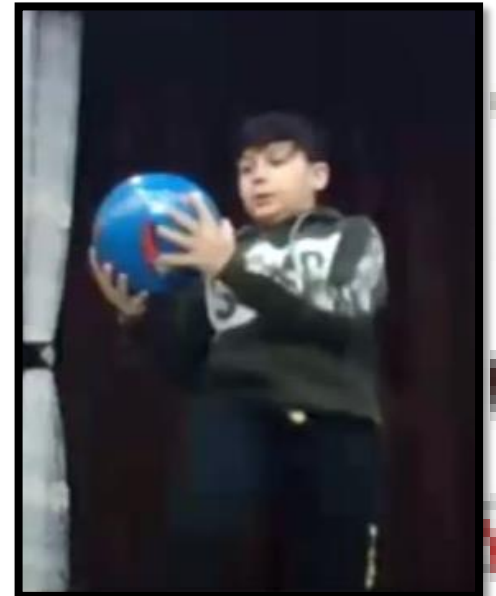


# Sports

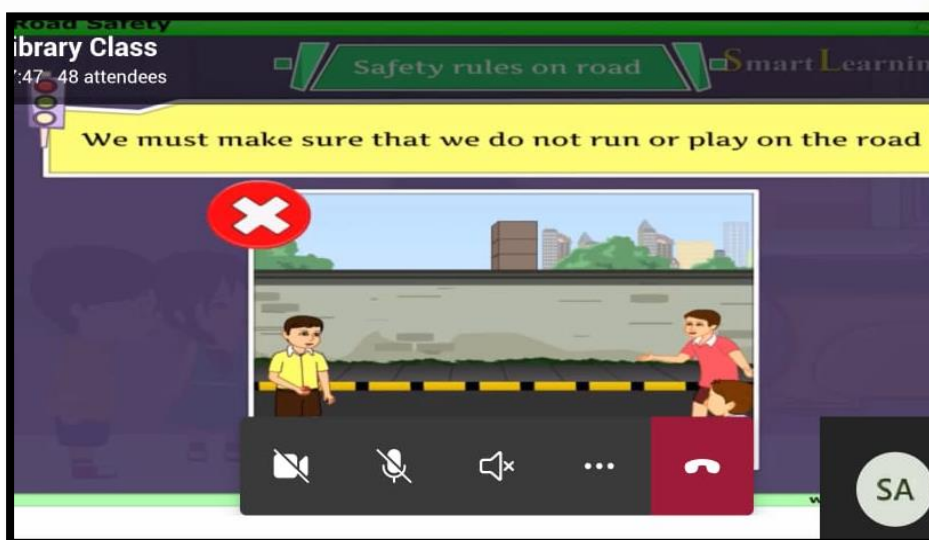

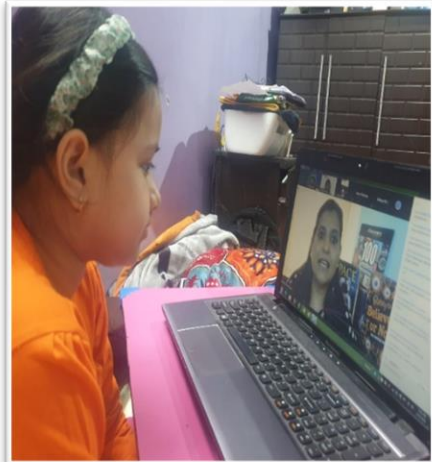
# ROAD SAFETY MONTH

Students learnt amazing facts about the Princely State of India-Rajasthan. They unleashed their creativity and made traditional door-hanging and a crafty model of a camel.



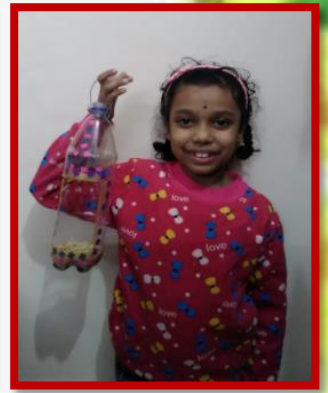


## CLUB: Hamaari Bagiya - Young Green Warriors

### January – My Planter

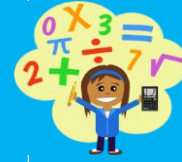

To motivate and make students practise good personal hygiene, they were asked to make videos displaying the right technique while washing hands. They also made their personal hygiene kits.

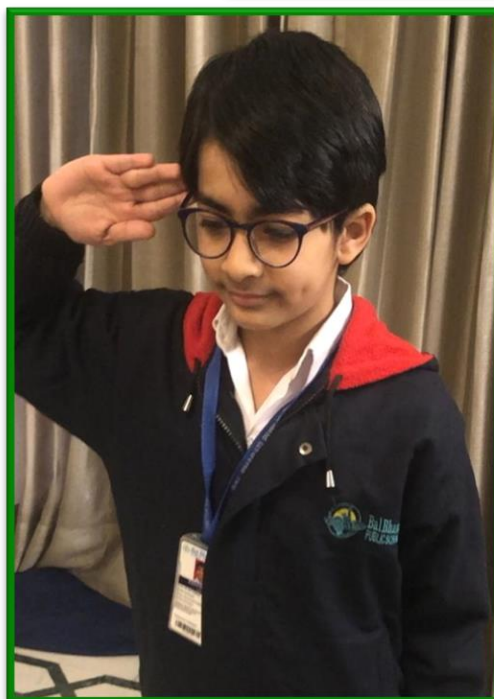
### December - Guarding Angels- Thank You card for our Soldiers

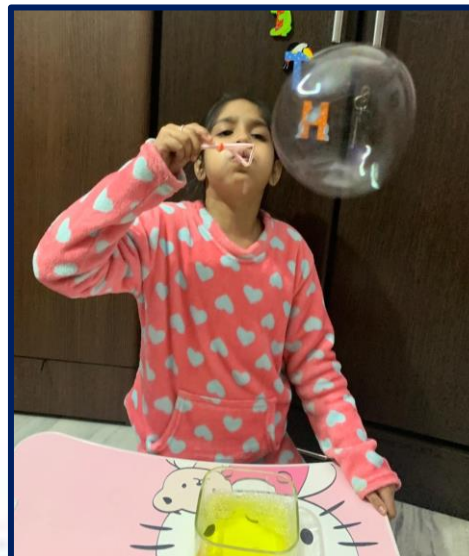


### December - Lemon Soda

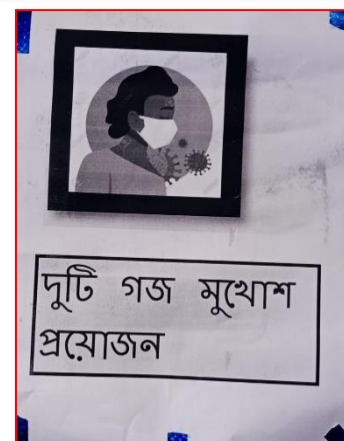
### November - जय हिन्द , जय भारत

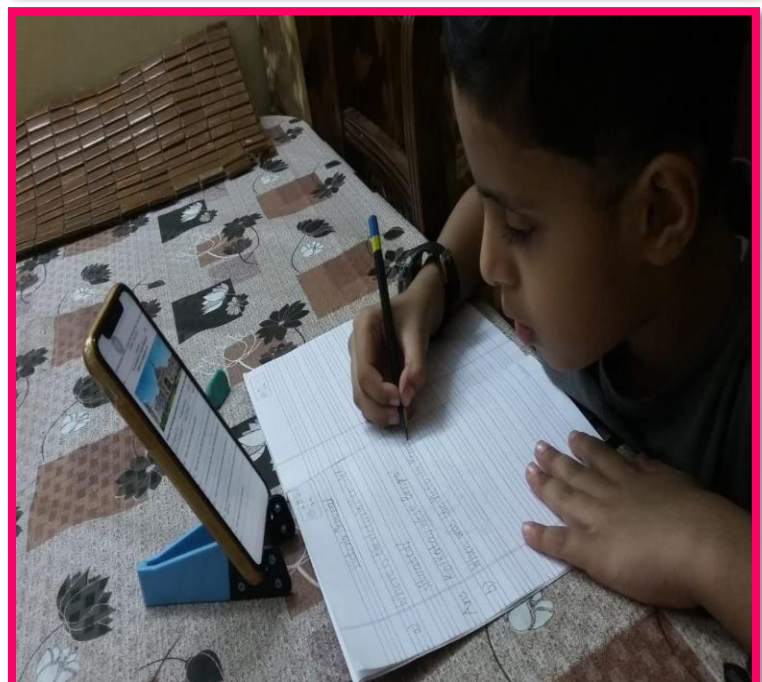
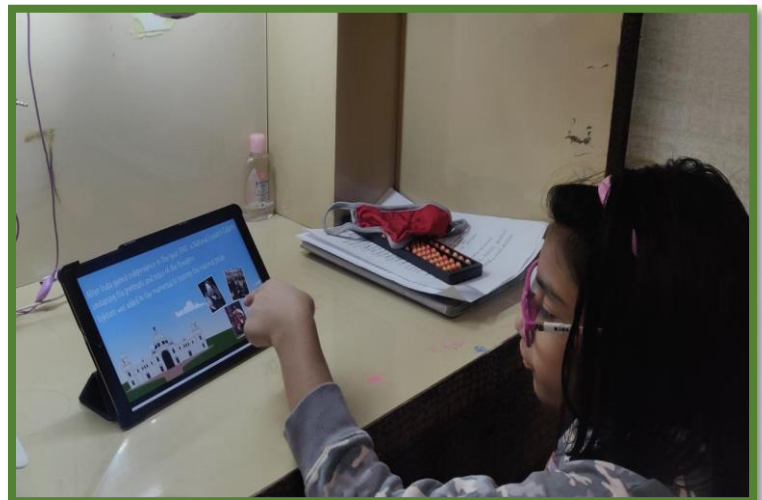




## VIRTUAL EXCURSIONS
