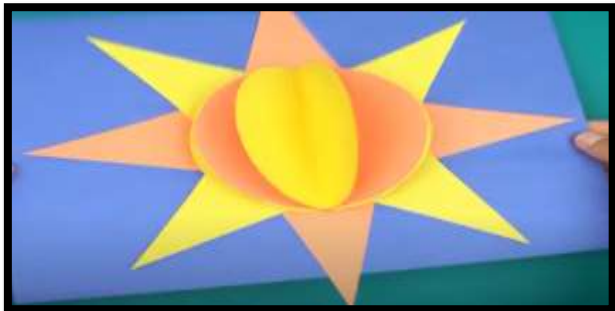
Fact Ant: The largest star, and indeed the only star in our solar system, is the Sun.
