# Dear Parents

As the fourth cycle assessments are scheduled in the month of February, we would like to apprise you with the date sheet and some important information regarding the same. Kindly go through the following points carefully:

- 1. The assessment will be conducted both in online and offline modes. CRISP Platform will be used for online assessment.
- 2. Each assessment for scholastic subjects will be of 15 marks except Mathematics. Assessment of Mathematics will be of 20 marks.
- 3. In this cycle assessment for co-scholastic subjects GK and Computers will also be conducted for 20 marks each. Complete syllabus of both third and fourth cycles will be covered for these two subjects. Students will also be assessed according to the parameters mentioned in the syllabus.
- 4. Other co-scholastic subjects are being assessed during the live classes on the parameters mentioned in the syllabus.
- 5. All questions will be objective in nature.
- 6. Time allotted for each assessment will be 30 minutes except for Mathematics where it is 42 minutes. Students must submit the answers within the prescribed time limit. Late submission will not be accepted.
- The timings for the assessment: <u>8:45 9:15 am for all the subjects except Mathematics for</u> which the timings will be 8:45 am – 9:27 am
- 8. <u>Please Note: Rest of the timetable will be followed as it is.</u>
- 9. Children are advised to watch all the modules regularly and practice worksheets and CRISP assessments.
- 10. They are further instructed to learn all the question answers thoroughly as objective questions will be framed from Questions-Answers of the lesson also.

## Assessment Plan - English, Hindi, Science and SST:

## **Types of questions:**

- 5 checkbox questions. These questions will have at least two correct options. A question may have more than 2 correct options as well. Marks will be allotted only when all the correct options are selected. Marks will not be awarded if a child selects any wrong option along with the correct ones.
- > 20 multiple choice questions with only one correct answer

#### Scheme of marks:

- > 5 checkboxes questions of ONE mark each: 5 Marks
- > 20 Multiple Choice Questions of HALF mark each: 10 Marks

#### **Assessment Plan - Mathematics:**

#### **Types of questions:**

- 8 check box questions. These questions will have at least two correct options. A question may have more than 2 correct options as well. Marks will be allotted only when all the correct options are selected. Marks will not be awarded if a child selects any wrong option along with the correct ones.
- > 24 multiple choice questions with only one correct answer

#### Scheme of marks:

- > 8 checkboxes questions of ONE mark each: 8 Marks
- > 24 Multiple Choice Questions of HALF mark each: 12 Marks

## **Assessment Plan - GK and Computer:**

#### **Types of questions:**

> 20 multiple choice questions with only one correct answer

> 20 Multiple Choice Questions of ONE mark each: 20 Marks
