SPACE invites entries for the annual WSW "National Astro-toon Competition" on the theme "Space and Sustainability" announced by World Space Week for Space enthusiasts. Participants can make cartoons related to Space and Sustainability, Space Debris, measuring climate change, identifying pollution on land and at sea, supporting agriculture in developing nations, etc, and participate in a friendly competition.

Information	Guidelines
About	In this activity, participants will draw or create a cartoon character relating to space. They can also include the main theme for this year ' Space & Sustainability ' in their art. If they wish they can give a character background.

Theme	Space and Sustainability <ul style="list-style-type: none"> WSW will celebrate two branches of the topic to be covered- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> achieving sustainability in space, and achieving sustainability from space. The theme is inspired by how sustainability in space relates to how humanity uses space, most pressingly, the orbital area surrounding Earth-itself a finite resource. There is a much greater story to tell in terms of how space exploration and remote Earth observation can help drive change for our own home planet.
