<b>Media Coverage</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shoot a video based on the theme for the year 2022.</li> <li>Post on any social media platforms (Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter), keeping Privacy Settings as Public.</li> <li>It is compulsory to tag @SPACEIndiaEdu (for Facebook), @spacian (for Twitter), and @space_india (for Instagram) and Use hashtags <a href="#">#SPACEIndia</a>, <a href="#">#DigitalIndia</a>, <a href="#">#ThinkShootUpload</a></li> </ul>
<b>Participation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The video should introduce only ONE participant. Volunteers can be involved</li> <li>A Team can create the video but registration will be ACCEPTED for one individual only. No Team registration will be accepted.</li> </ul>
<b>Categories For Participation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Category 1 [Class 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup>]</li> <li>Category 2 [Class 4<sup>th</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup>]</li> <li>Category 3 [Class 6<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup>]</li> <li>Category 4 [Class 10<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>]</li> <li>Category 5 [Adult]</li> </ul>
<b>Results &amp; Awards</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In each category 1st, 2nd &amp; 3rd Prize will be given and one most popular Video will be selected from the overall categories.</li> <li>Likes and share on the videos will be counted till 24th October 2022 and final results will be announced till last week of November.</li> <li>Winners will get an Appreciation Certificate recognized by SPACE India with Space goodies. Participants will be given certificates for their efforts.</li> </ul>
<b>Video Format and Duration</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Format used for the video should be .mpeg, .mov, .avi, .mp4, etc. Duration of the video must not exceed 2 Minutes.</li> </ul>

<b>Video Shooting Parameters</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The video can be shot using a webcam, phone video recorder, digital cameras video camcorders and DSLR</li> <li>Audio needs to be clear and audible. Common and easily available software can be used for editing.</li> </ul>
<b>Selection Parameter</b>	<p>The entries will be judged on the following basis:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Creativity and originality in presenting the topic.</li> <li>Use of interesting and creative modes and teaching aids to explain the topic.</li> <li>Scientific approach of the video and correct use of scientific terms.</li> <li>Statically biased video i.e. the difference between the result and true value should be the same.</li> <li>Innovative idea, message, or thought was delivered in an original and imaginative way.</li> <li><b>Most Popular:</b> There will be only one winner out of all the entries. The maximum number of likes generated on the video link that is registered will be considered. The likes generated on the shared video will not be considered.</li> </ol>
<b>Important Note</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For the award category of Most Popular likes the video with a fake profile will be discarded.</li> <li>The podcasts will be judged based on the originality of the idea, science content, clarity of the concept, and its delivery along with usage of aids.</li> <li>By submitting your video, you are promising that you own all rights to all material in your video, including the music, images, script, and rights to include all persons, places or organizations included or depicted. SPACE India will have distribution rights for non-commercial use, and video makers will have co-distribution rights for either public or commercial use.
