Dear Parents

This syllabus document contains the details of scholastic and co-scholastic subjects for the session 2023-24.

Scholastic Subjects

- For assessing the students' performance across various scholastic subjects, pen and paper exams (Periodic Test 1, Midterm Exam, Periodic test 2 and Final Exams) will be conducted during the entire session.
- Besides these pen and paper exams, students' performance will also be assessed continuously through subject enrichment activities, project work, multiple assessments, and portfolio.
- The details of subject enrichment activities and project work are mentioned with the syllabus of each subject.
- Multiple Assessments will also be conducted for each subject in the form of spell check, listening, speaking, and writing activities, concept mapping, map work, diagrams etc. as per the subject's requirement. Subject teachers will be informing students from time to time about these assessments, giving the requisite guidelines for the same.
- Student's portfolio assessment for each subject will consist of notebook assessment, class performance, and subject exploration.

Co – scholastic Subjects

- For each co-scholastic subject the syllabus has been mentioned.
- For G.K and Computers, pen and paper exams will be conducted during the Midterm Exam and Final Exam.
- For co- scholastic subjects students' performance will be assessed regularly on the parameters mentioned in the syllabus.
