AQUATIC ANIMALS

- Ocean in a bottle: Fill a clean bottle halfway with water. Add powder glitter and mini toy sea creatures to it. Watch the glitter and sea creatures move in the water as you shake the bottle.
- Paper plate aquarium: Make a miniature underwater world out of a paper plate, craft paper, poster colours, and clean film.
- Accordion fold paper fish mobile: Use a simple paper folding technique, to make at least five colourful fish. Create a mobile using the fish.
- Eggy the crocodile: Use an egg tray, craft paper, and poster colours, to create a crocodile puppet.



Art Work

Make a pencil holder out of a soft drink can. Cover it with blue paper and colourful paper aquatic animals.

Pre School C & Pre School D

FARM ANIMALS

- Masks and Head Gear: Make at least two masks/headgear of your favourite farm animal out of a paper plate, construction paper, and scrap materials.
- <u>Jigsaw Puzzle:</u> Make a box with a set of two jigsaw puzzles (6"* 6") out of waste cardboard, colourful paper, and poster colours.
- Box Farm animal: Make a farm animal out of cardboard boxes and brightly
- Piggy Bank: Create a piggy bank out of an old pet bottle and poster paint.

Art Work

Use cotton, wobbly eyes, and paper cups to make fluffy paper cup sheep.

WILD ANIMALS

- Masks: Using construction paper, poster colours, and other materials, make two
 masks of your favourite wild animal.
- <u>Dioramas:</u> Make dioramas of various animal habitats, such as a rainforest or a desert, out of materials such as construction paper, tissue paper, pebbles, cotton, and so on.
- Puppets: Encourage children to make at least two
 wild animal puppets out of paper bags, construction paper, and other craft
 materials.
- <u>Domino:</u> Make a set of dominos (6 pairs) of wild animals and their babies out of cardboard, colourful paper, poster colours, and other materials.

Art Work: Make a snake/cobra out of paper chains.

Pre School G & Pre School H

PET ANIMALS

- <u>Masks:</u> Create a mask of your favourite pet animal out of construction paper, poster colours, and other materials.
- <u>Pen/pencil stand:</u> Create a pen stand out of an empty can, colourful paper, poster paint, and scrap materials. Draw or copy a picture of a pet animal.
- <u>Paper Toys</u>: Use paper bags, construction paper, and other craft materials to make paper toys of at least two pet animals. They can act out stories or play pretend with their toys.
- My milk mug: Using paint and wobbly eyes, draw or paint any of your favourite pet animal on a white ceramic mug.

<u>Art Work</u>: Make a pot using used pet bottles and paint your favourite pet animal on it using poster colours.

BIRDS & INSECTS

- <u>DIY Bird feeders</u>: Make bird feeders using materials like pinecones, coconut shells, egg trays, peanut shells, and bird seeds. Children can hang them outside and observe which birds come to eat.
- <u>Bird and insect collage</u>: Let the children create a collage of different birds and insects using construction paper, tissue paper, and other materials. They can learn about the different colours and shapes of these animals.
- <u>Bird Habitat</u>: Collect feathers, leaves and other natural materials to make a nest or a habitat for your toy bird.
- **Pot Painting**: Paint & decorate a pot to feed the birds with water to quench their thirst.
- Art Work: Make a pair of Rocking Hen using paper plate, craft paper and wobbly eyes.
