The SDGs selected for each class are as follows:

Through these activities, you will reflect on how you can contribute to a healthier, greener, and kinder world.

Understanding the SDGs

The SDGs, proposed by the United Nations, are a set of 17 global goals designed to address the world's most pressing challenges—from poverty and hunger to health, education, environmental conservation, and climate action. As young global citizens, it's important to learn how we can take care of ourselves, each other, and our planet.

What will you be doing?

Through hands-on activities, creativity, and reflection, you will explore the following SDGs:

- SDG 15: Life on Land Protecting our forests, wildlife, and ecosystems
- SDG 13: Climate Action Taking steps to combat climate change
- SDG 3: Good Health and Well-Being Promoting healthy habits and mental wellness

These creative assignments will help you become more informed, empathetic, and responsible individuals, all while contributing to a better future.

All the children have to:

- revise all the work done in the class.
- do the theme-based assignment/project work allotted to their section.
- attempt the 4 subject based worksheets.

Art Holidays Homework

1. Dot Mandala Art on Cardboard.

Make a beautiful **Dot Mandala** design using colorful dots.

What to do:

- Take a round cardboard cutout (6 inches in diameter).
- Paint the base with black or any dark color.
- Use earbuds, the back of a brush, or any round tool to make dot patterns.
- Start from the center and move outwards in neat, circular designs using different colors.
- Use mirrors for decoration. (Optional)

- Use gentle hands on the keyboard.

Roll no- 31-onwards Design a 3D Fairy Tale Castle

Build a 3D fairy tale castle using paper, cardboard, or craft materials. Create towers, walls, and doors by cutting and assembling shapes to make your castle stand up. Then decorate it with colours, glitter, stickers, and other fun craft supplies.

Class II Sustainable Development Goal Life on Land

Our children will care if we show them how.



Land and forests are the foundation of sustainable development. Forests cover 30% of the Earth's surface and, in addition to providing food security and shelter, are key to combating climate change, protecting biodiversity and are home to the indigenous population. The Sustainable Development Goal 15 'Life on Earth' is all about protecting, restoring and promoting the sustainable use of all terrestrial ecosystems so that we can have a better future. The activities aim to educate our young learners about the need for and importance of conservation of the environment.

II A Theme: Trees and Plant Life

Roll no. 1 to 12 – 3D Model of Plant Life Cycle

Create a 3D model showing the stages of a plant's life cycle (seed, germination, seedling, mature plant, flower/fruit). Use cardboard, clay, and recycled materials.

Roll no. 13 to 24 – Biodiversity Park Model

Design a 3D model of a biodiversity park showcasing different types of plants and animals. Include a pond or stream. Use eco-friendly materials.

Roll no. 25 to 36 – My Favourite Tree Journal

Create an A4-size, 5–6-page journal about your favourite tree. Include drawings, its uses, and a pledge to protect trees.

Roll no. 37 to 48 - Dry Leaf Art

Make a picture or figure using dry leaves and twigs on an A3 sheet. Enhance it with natural dyes or watercolours.

II B Theme: Forests and Conservation

Roll no. 1 to 12 - Composting Model

Create a 3D model of a compost bin showing different layers. Use clay, cardboard, and paper.

Roll no. 13 to 24 – Uses of Forests Wall Hanging

Make an A3-size wall hanging showing the benefits of forests. Use drawings, fabric, or recycled materials.

Roll no. 25 to 36 – Trees as Animal Shelters Collage

Create a collage on an A3 sheet showing animals that shelter in trees. Use cutouts or dry leaves. Write 5 lines on how animals depend on trees.

Roll no. 37 to 48 – Table Calendar on Conservation

Design a 12-month calendar (Size - A5) with plant images and conservation tips. Use recycled and natural materials for decoration.

II C Theme: Types and Uses of Plants

Roll no. 1 to 12 – Plants Display

Create a 3D model showing different types of plants. Use clay, cardboard, and twigs. Label each type.

Roll no. 13 to 24 – Interdependence of Plants and Animals Scrapbook

Make a 5–6-page scrapbook showing how plants and animals help each other. Add drawings and 2–3 sentence descriptions.

Roll no. 25 to 36 – Plants Platter

Create a 3D platter showing plant-based foods. Use clay, paper, or fabric. Write 5 lines about the role of plants in our diet.

Roll no. 37 to 48 – National Trees of Countries

Design an A3 poster showing national trees of 5 countries. Draw the trees and write one use for each.

II D Theme: Trees and Everyday Life

Roll no. 1 to 12 - Uses of Coconut

Create a 3D model with captions showing uses of a coconut (e.g., water, oil, crafts). Use clay, fabric, and cardboard.

Roll no. 13 to 24 – Spice Box Craft

Create a spice box using recycled containers. Include 5 spice models and write one use for each (culinary/medicinal).

Roll no. 25 to 36 – Terrarium

Create a simple terrarium using a clear container, soil, and small plants.

Roll no. 37 to 48 – Conservation Journal

Create a 5–6 page A4-size journal on the theme: Conservation of Land Resources'. Include drawings, natural materials, and tips on protecting and preserving land resources.

II E Theme: Biodiversity and Trees

Roll no. 1 to 12 – Biodiversity Park Diorama

Make a 3D A3-size diorama of a biodiversity park with plants, animals, and water. Use clay, twigs, and natural materials.

Roll no. 13 to 24 - Uses of Forests Poster

Create an A3-size poster showing uses of forest. Use drawings and dry leaves.

Roll no. 25 to 36 – My Favourite Tree Model

Make a 3D model (A3 size) of your favourite tree. Include roots, trunk, and leaves. Write 5 uses of the tree.

Roll no. 37 to 48 – Trees as Shelters Scrapbook

Create a 5–6-page scrapbook showing animals that live on trees. Add drawings and 2–3 lines for each.

II F Theme: Plants Around Us

Roll no. 1 to 12 – Plant Life Cycle Mobile

Create a hanging mobile with captions showing stages of plant life cycle. Use cardboard and strings.

Roll no. 13 to 24 – Food from Plants Booklet

Make a 5–6 page booklet about foods we get from plants. Draw or paste cutouts and write a fact for each item.

Roll no. 25 to 36 – National Trees Wall Hanging

Create an A3-size wall hanging on national fruits of 5 countries. Include names and one use of each. Use fabric, dry leaves, or paper.

Roll no. 37 to 48 - Composting Poster

Design an A3 poster explaining composting steps and benefits. Use recycled materials and write 5 points about composting.

Theme: Interdependence and Sustainability

Roll no. 1 to 12 – Terrarium

Create a simple terrarium using a clear container, soil, and small plants.

Roll no. 13 to 24 – Conservation Table Calendar

Create a colourful 12-month calendar where each month features a hand-drawn plant and a simple eco-friendly tip. Use recycled paper and natural materials.

Roll no. 25 to 36 – Spice Box Craft

Make a spice box using recycled items. Include 5 spice models and write one use for each.

Roll no. 37 to 48 – Dry Leaf Art

Create a nature-themed artwork on A3 paper using dry leaves and highlight it with natural dyes for added colour. Write 3–4 lines explaining how leaves play an important role in ecosystems by providing oxygen, food, and shelter to many living beings.
