Understanding the SDGs

The SDGs, proposed by the United Nations, are a set of 17 global goals designed to address the world's most pressing challenges—from poverty and hunger to health, education, environmental conservation, and climate action. As young global citizens, it's important to learn how we can take care of ourselves, each other, and our planet.

What will you be doing?

Through hands-on activities, creativity, and reflection, you will explore the following SDGs:

- SDG 15: Life on Land Protecting our forests, wildlife, and ecosystems
- SDG 13: Climate Action Taking steps to combat climate change
- SDG 3: Good Health and Well-Being Promoting healthy habits and mental wellness

These creative assignments will help you become more informed, empathetic, and responsible individuals, all while contributing to a better future.


Make a beautiful Rangoli using papier-mâché paste on a firm base like cardboard, canvas, or MDF board. (Size- 8 inch in diameter)



Steps to follow:

- 1. Take old newspapers or tissue papers and tear them into small pieces.
- 2. Soak the paper pieces in water overnight or for a few hours until soft.
- 3. Blend or mash the paper into a paste.
- 4. Mix fevicol into the paste.
- 5. Add bright poster or acrylic colours to the paste.
- 6. Draw a rangoli design (refer to the image given below) on your base (8 inch in diameter).
- 7. Use your hands or a spoon to fill the design with coloured papier-mâché paste.
- 8. Once dry, decorate it with mirrors, or any other decorative material.

Class III Sustainable Development Goal Life on Land

'Our children will care if we show them how'.



Land and forests are the foundation of sustainable development. Forests cover 30% of the Earth's surface and, in addition to providing food security and shelter, are key to combating climate change, protecting biodiversity and are home to the indigenous population. The Sustainable Development Goal 15 'Life on Earth' is all about protecting, restoring and promoting the sustainable use of all terrestrial ecosystems so that we can have a better future. The activities aim to educate our young learners about the need for and importance of conservation of the environment.

III A Theme: Animal Life on Mountains

Roll no.: 1 to 12 - 3D Model of a Mountain Animal Habitat

Create a 3D diorama or model showing the habitat of a mountain animal such as a snow leopard, mountain goat, or Himalayan tahr.

Roll no.: 13 to 24 Poster: Mountain Wildlife Adaptations

Design a vibrant poster showcasing three mountain animals (such as the Yaks, Snow Leopards, and Mountain Eagles) and their unique adaptations to the cold, high altitude environment.

Roll no.: 25 to 36 - Mountain Animals

Make colourful cutouts of any 2 mountain animals. (approx.2 feet).

Roll no.: 37 to 48 - Animal Tracking Footprint Display

Create cutouts of animal footprints of three mountain animal using clay/play dough.

Design an A3 poster that depicting how mountain animals survive the extreme weather conditions in their environment.

Roll no. 25 to 36 - Mountain Animal Tracks Chart

Create a keychain of a mountain animal using clay, highlighting its unique features through your design.

Roll no. 37 to 48 - Mountain Animal Pop-Up Card

Create a pop-up card that shows a mountain ecosystem with a snow leopard, mountain goat, or other mountain animals.

III D Theme: Animal Life on Plains and Deserts

Roll no. 1 to 12 - Diorama of Animal Life in the Plains

Create a small 3D diorama of a plain, including animals such as gazelles, lions or cheetahs.

Roll no. 13 to 24 - Animal Adaptation Poster

Create an A3 size colourful poster showcasing how animals like camels, fennec foxes, and desert tortoises adapt to the extreme conditions of the desert.

Roll no. 25 to 36 - Clay Model of Desert Animals

Create clay models of desert animals such as snakes, lizards, and scorpions.

Roll no. 37 to 48 - Interactive Animal Track Map

Create a table calendar depicting 12 different desert animals.

III E Theme: Animal Life on Plains and Deserts

Roll no. 1 to 12 - Animal Life Cycle Spinner

Make a model of an animal burrow, such as a prairie dog or a desert tortoise, using natural materials like clay, twigs, leaves, and cotton.
