Class IV Sustainable Development Goal 13 Climate Action

Climate change is no longer a far-off problem; it is happening here; it is happening now.



Climate change is a global challenge that does not respect national borders. It is disrupting national economies and affecting lives, costing people, communities and countries dearly today and even more tomorrow. People are experiencing significant impacts of climate change, which include changing weather patterns, rising sea levels, and more extreme weather events.

IV A Theme: Little Artists For Earth

Roll no. 1-12: Poster Making

Draw a poster on an A3 sheet on the topic 'Say No to Pollution' using recycled material.

Roll no. 13-24: Climate Comic Strip

Create a 4-panel comic strip showing a superhero saving the Earth from pollution.

Roll no. 25-36: Nature Mandala

Collect natural items (leaves, twigs, pebbles) and design a mandala art pattern.

Roll no. 37 onwards: Slogan Collage

Cut out words from newspapers/magazines and make a catchy slogan on an A3 sheet on the theme - Save Earth.

IV B Theme: Young Scientists

Roll no. 1-12: Mini Greenhouse Experiment

Grow a plant in a recycled bottle and prepare a journal on its growth.

Roll no. 13-24: Weather Report Diary

Record daily weather for 10 days in a scrap book highlighting changes or patterns.

Roll no. 25-36: Carbon Footprint Tracker

Track one week's use of electricity, transport, water at home and make a carbon footprint tracker record on an A3 sheet.

Roll no. 37 onwards: Climate Quiz

Create quiz flash cards (10 questions) on climate change.

IV C Climate Storytellers

Roll no. 1-12: Story Writing

Write a short story titled 'How I Saved My Planet' and present it creatively on an A3 sheet.

Roll no. 13-24: Climate Poem

Compose a poem on the beauty of nature and why we must protect it and present it creatively on an A3 sheet.

Roll no. 25-36: Puppet Talk

Make two puppets using socks or paper and write a short dialogue about saving water on an A3 sheet.

Roll no. 37 onwards: Interview a Tree

Imagine a tree could speak. Write an interview asking how it feels about climate change and present it creatively on a tree cutout.

Plant a sapling and name it. Keep a photo record of its weekly progress and make a table mat representing the same.

Conduct an energy audit at home by identifying unnecessary energy use, suggest ways to reduce it, and creatively represent your findings and solutions on a hanging wall display using pictures, and drawings.

Roll no. 37 onwards: Water Saving Tips Poster

Make a colourful chart with at least 5 water-saving tips.

Roll no. 1-12: Solar Oven Model

Make a simple solar oven using a pizza box or shoebox.

Roll no. 13-24: Windmill Craft

Create a paper windmill and learn how wind energy works.

Roll no. 25-36: Recycling Detective

Find at least 5 items at home that can be reused or recycled and create a decorative item.

Roll no. 37 onwards: Eco-Invention Drawing

Think and design your own machine that will help stop climate change and create a 3D model.

Roll no. 1-12: No-Fire Recipe

Make a recipe card of a healthy, no-fire dish using local ingredients.

Roll no. 13-24: Food Waste Tracker

Keep a 3-day record of leftover food and suggest how to reduce waste, present it creatively in the form of a flip book.

Roll no. 25-36: Compost in a Bottle

Create a mini compost with fruit peels and plant waste in a transparent bottle.

Roll no. 37 onwards: Nature Platter Art

Decorate a full-size plate creatively using nut shells and other natural food items to create ecofriendly art.
