Subjects: English, Hindi, III Language

General Instructions

- 1. Create a folder decorated with symbols and images representing unity, peace, and cultural diversity. Use drawings, cutouts, or relevant quotes that promote communal harmony.
- 2. Ensure neatness and creativity in both the design and the writing. Your work should be clear, engaging, and aligned with the theme.
- 3. Class, section and roll number along with subject name must be mentioned and highlighted at the bottom of the cover page.

ENGLISH

Instructions:

- 1. Imagine you attended a workshop on the importance of communal harmony in school today. Write a diary entry (150-200 words) on a coloured A 4 size sheet reflecting on your experience. Include important facts shared during the workshop. You can also add contemporary examples from your life, media, or current events that highlight the need for communal harmony.
- 2. Use a personal, reflective tone in your diary entry. Your writing should be honest and expressive, showing your understanding of communal harmony and its role in today's world.
- 3. **Decorate your sheet** with relevant visuals. Ensure that your diary entry is visually engaging and organized.

Sanskrit

शीर्षकः विविधतायाम् एकतायाः प्रतिध्वनिः साम्प्रदायिक सौहार्दस्य स्थापना च (विविधता में एकता की गूंज और साम्प्रदायिक सौहार्द की स्थापना)

चित्रण Canva के माध्यम से देश की विभिन्न संस्कृतियों और भाषाओं को एक साथ A4 पर चित्रित करें।

रंग योजनाः इंद्रधनुषी रंगों का उपयोग करें जो विविधता और एकता दोनों का प्रतीक हों। बार्डरः भारतीय पारपरिक कलाओं जैसे मधुबनी या वारली कला से प्रेरित बॉर्डर बनाएं। विविधता में एकता से संबंधित संस्कृत में दो स्लोगन अर्थ के साथ लिखकर A4 रंगीन पत्र पर तैयार करें। विद्यार्थी Canva पर प्रस्तृत करके उसका प्रिंट भी निकाल सकते हैं।

German:

German Vocabulary Tree - "Baum der Einheit"

Design a **poster with a message in German** that promotes communal harmony.

Include:

- A slogan (Example: "Alle Menschen sind gleich!")
 Draw a tree. On each leaf, write one German word related to unity and peace, such as:
 - Respekt (respect)
 - Zusammen (together)
 - Hilfe (help)
 - Freundschaft (friendship)

Decorate it with flags of countries that live in harmony in Germany.

French:

Title: Nous sommes tous amis (We Are All Friends)

Task: Create a 4-box comic strip showing children from different cultures being friends or celebrating together.

Instructions:

- Draw or paste simple characters.
- Add short French dialogues in speech bubbles.
- Write the English translation below each box.

Example:

Box 1:

Fille 1 : Aujourd'hui, c'est ma fête!

(Girl 1: Today is my festival!)

Box 2:

Fille 2 : Super ! On va célébrer ensemble. (Girl 2: Great! We will celebrate together.)

Box 3:

Fille 1: Tu veux goûter les sucreries? (Girl 1: Do you want to try the sweets?)

Box 4:

Les deux : Vive l'amitié ! (Both: Long live friendship!)

Group 2: Paper Bags

General Instructions:

- 1. Create a handmade paper or jute bag that represents the theme.
- 2. Decorate the bag representing communal harmony. You can use drawings, cutouts or 3D elements like fabric, beads, or thread.
- 3. Ensure neatness and clarity in both the writing and design. Your bag should reflect your understanding of the theme.
- 4. Class, section and roll number along with subject name must be mentioned and highlighted at the bottom of the cover page.

Subjects: G.Science, Mathematics and Social Science

THEME: Echoes of Unity: Cultivating Communal Harmony in a Diverse

World

Instructions for Submission:

Students are required to design a beautiful, hand-decorated paper bag that reflects the theme of unity and harmony. Neatly place three A4-sized activity sheets inside—one each for Science, Mathematics and Social Science.

Be as creative and thoughtful as possible in your presentation. Use diagrams, colour, captions, and well-organised content to express your ideas meaningfully.

Sheet 1 – General Science

Title: Communal Harmony in Nature – Learning from Ecosystems

Create a visually appealing presentation (A4 size) that illustrates a natural relationship between organisms that represents communal harmony.

Your sheet must include:

- 1. The name of the ecological interaction (e.g., mutualism, commensalism, symbiosis)
- 2. An illustration or labeled diagram
- 3. A short explanation of how the organisms interact
- 4. A meaningful message: What can humans learn from this natural partnership?

Choose any one example from the following or any other of your choice:

- Bees and Flowers (Mutualism)
- Cattle and Egrets (Commensalism)
- Lichen Algae and Fungi (Symbiosis)

- Ant Colonies (Animal Cooperation)
- Birds and Plants (Seed Dispersal)

Sheet 2 – Mathematics

Title: Unity in Numbers – A Mathematical View of Diversity

Use an A4 sheet to create a pie chart based on the following data representing a harmonious community of diverse religions:

- Hindu 30%
- Muslim 25%
- Christian 20%
- Sikh 15%
- Others 10%

Also answer:

- 1. Which community has the largest and smallest population?
- 2. What percentage does the Christian group represent?
- 3. If the total population is 1000, calculate how many people belong to each group.

Extension: Add a few lines on how mathematics helps us understand and appreciate diversity.

Sheet 3 - Social Science

Title: A Taste of Harmony – Exploring India and Indonesia's Shared Food Heritage

Part A – Reflection (250–300 words):

Research the cultural and historical connections between India and Indonesia through trade, religion and migration. Reflect on how these connections have influenced food traditions and led to shared ingredients, dishes or cooking styles.

Part B – Visual Comparison Chart:

Choose a common dish or type of cuisine (e.g., rice dishes, coconut-based curries, satay) and prepare a side-by-side comparison of how it appears in India vs. Indonesia using pictures or drawings. Show:

- Similar ingredients or spices
- Cooking methods
- Serving styles and occasions
